Title Courtesy transportation		Effective date August 30, 2016
Statement	 Recognizing that there are special or exceptional situations to be considered on a case-by-case basis, CTSE has established a regulation for granting access to courtesy transportation. Those may only be granted in the interest of the students and should in no case incur additional costs, lengthen the routes, penalize the students who already have transportation, or create a precedent. CTSE avoid filling buses at full capacity so that they can manage new applications for students who are eligible for transportation. On average, CTSE aims at an occupancy rate of 85% and never more than 95%.

	 notifies the applicant of his decision at the email address provided on the form and explains the reasons; maintains an up-to-date list of students who have been given an empty seat; 	
	If there is equality in the criteria, the student who lives the farthest from the school will take precedence for the transportation.	
	For students from grade 7 to 12, the seats will be allocated starting with the student whose home is furthest from the school.
