Transportation of equipment in school vehicles	April 1, 2017

Statement	No large equipment is accepted in school vehicles to avoid compromising the safety of all persons on board. Any object must be placed inside a backpack	
Terms	Prohibited equipment on board of a school vehicle:	
	 Arms of all kinds; animals, with the exception of service dogs (Reference to CTSE040); skis, ski poles and snowboards; child scooters; any dangerous or hazardous object; hockey equipment; any equipment longer than 30 inches. 	
	Accepted equipment on board of a school véhicle:	
	 skates with blade guards, roller blades and skateboards stowed in a bag no larger than a school bag and placed at the student's feet; curriculum related objects stored in a bag that can be safely placed at the student's feet; a musical instrument stored in a case, placed at the student's feet and not exceeding 30 inches. 	
	Other objects: CTSE, in collaboration with the principal and the operator, will decide in advance which other items can be transported in a school vehicle, to and from school.	
	Note: in the event of a disagreement on the acceptance of particular objects, the final decision will be made by the driver.
