Terms	 The number of patrollers varies depending on the number of buses servicing school, but CTSE recommends that there be at least two patrollers per be Patrollers shall cooperate, within their capabilities, with the driver to remind students of the safety and order instructions. A school bus patrol shall be established in accordance with the follow conditions: Select responsible students in grades 5 and/or 6; obtain written consent from parents or guardians for students to act school bus patrollers; provide adequate training from a police force; Student acting as school bus patroller must: Wear the school bus patrol safety vest; help students to get and off the bus when they arrive at and leave school; encourage students to respect the code of conduct; assist the school bus driver when needed. 	the ing
