Title School zones and Out of boundary attendance	Effective date April 1, 2017

Statement School zones	<p>The establishment of the school zones remains the responsibility of the member boards. However, the boards should consult the CTSE when creating new zones or for the modification of the existing zones.</p> <p>Students attend school in their zone, which is determined by the place of residence or the permanent location of daycare.</p>
Statement – Out of boundary attendance	<p>The Superintendent of education responsible for the Students with special needs Services, may authorize a student to attend an out of boundary school to follow a program for special needs students. Transportation is ensured.</p> <p>Superintendence may exceptionally allow out of boundary attendance for other reasons.</p> <p>CTSE supplies transportation if the Superintendent of business approves it. CTSE has no authority to approve or deny an out of boundary application or its associated transportation.</p>
Procedures – Out of boundary attendance	<p>The parent must complete the "Request for Out of boundary attendance" form at the school in its school zone.</p>
