Title Special Education transportation	Effective Date August 28, 2012

Statement	<p>A special Education transportation request may be made if the student meets the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • is identified by the Special Education Services of one of the school boards as requiring special transportation; • attends a distinct class in a specialized module that is outside the student's attendance area; • has a permanent physical handicap that prevents him from boarding a bus and getting to his seat; • has a medical condition which requires special transportation (in this case the application must be accompanied by a medical certificate); • attends a treatment center.
Terms	<p>The form <i>Special Education Transportation Request</i> must be completed by the school administration and sent to CTSE. Once the form is received, CTSE will evaluate the application to determine which transportation is the most adequate and safe for the student.</p> <p>For students identified by the Special Education Services of one of the school boards, the procedure is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • by default, they are transported by regular transportation; • the Special Education Services must provide CTSE with a list of the students identified for the next school year (before the end of the current school year); • CTSE, in collaboration with Special Education Services, maintains the list of students identified by class and school; • if a student has special needs, following the recommendation from the Special Education Services, special transportation by bus or van is arranged.
