Title School Patrol	Effective date August 30, 2016

Statement	<p>CTSE, for safety purposes, established a school bus patrol program for each of the elementary school buses in its territory. The program is managed the CTSE Security Officer in collaboration with the CAA, the regional Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) and a lead person in each of the elementary school.</p> <p>CTSE provides annual training to school bus patrol program leaders at each school and to the selected school bus patrollers.</p>
Terms	<p>The number of patrollers varies depending on the number of buses servicing the school, but CTSE recommends that there be at least two patrollers per bus. Patrollers shall cooperate, within their capabilities, with the driver to remind the students of the safety and order instructions.</p> <p>A school bus patrol shall be established in accordance with the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select responsible students in grades 5 and/or 6; • obtain written consent from parents or guardians for students to act as school bus patrollers; • provide adequate training from a police force; <p>Student acting as school bus patroller must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wear the school bus patrol safety vest; • help students to get and off the bus when they arrive at and leave the school; • encourage students to respect the code of conduct; • assist the school bus driver when needed.
